

The Chiropractic Association of Louisiana Presents Cajun Minestrone Continuing Education: A Blend of Spicy Topics and Clinical Updates June 11-12, 2022

#### About this Program:

In this new 15 hour course, Dr. Bart Green, D.C., MSEd, PhD, DACBSP will discuss up-to-date methods to evaluate and treat hip disorders He will discuss hip disorders with a focus on current trends in diagnosis and treatment for hip pain, including femoracetabular impingement, femoroacetabular labral tears, and soft tissue injuries. This presentation will also bring you up-to-date on research pertaining to spine disorders and how that research can be applied in practice and community. Attendees will leave this session with skills that can be applied on Monday morning. Dr. Green will explore the importance of endurance training in spine rehabilitation. Clinical lumbar instability, a clinical entity that is often seen but poorly understood, will be presented and skills to produce better clinical outcomes will be learned and practiced. Cases highlighting the principles and procedures will be shared and discussed. Risk factors for spine concerns will also be presented.

Some of the topics of discussion during this seminar will include:

- \* Being able to differentiate various pain-generating tissues in the hip and differentially diagnose hip pain
- \* How to perform clinical tests for femoracetabular impingement and perform corrective exercises for various types of hip disorders
- \* How to discuss preferred manipulation and soft tissue treatments for some hip disorders
- \* Assessing spine endurance capacity and providing intervention to increase spine endurance capacity
- \* Defining, assessing, and treatment strategies for clinical lumbar spine instability
- \* Recent evidence and research in spine care practice and those risk factors associated with spine pain
- \* Listing clinical outcome measures for spinal rehabilitation
- Risk management and ethics is also included in this presentation

**Bart Green**, D.C., M.S.Ed, Ph.D., DACBSP, is a full time chiropractor and epidemiologist, practicing in an interdisciplinary, on-site health center that serves a large corporation in San Diego and San Jose, California. He previously started the first chiropractic clinic for the military in San Diego at the Naval Medical Center, practicing for 13 years as an interprofessional teammate in spine, sports, and combat casualty care clinics and serves as cycling coach for the United States Marine Corps Air Station Miramar endurance sports team. He has been in private practice and served as a clinician-educator at two chiropractic colleges. A second-generation Chiropractor, his chiropractic roots go back more than 75 years. He knows how to blend the old with the new and has been an advocate and financial supporter of chiropractic history research for his entire career. Dr Green has published more than 100 research papers in scientific and academic journals and served as a collaborator in multiple research projects. Most recently, he served as a volunteer researcher for the Global Spine Care Initiative, an international collaboration of 68 international spine experts from 24 countries, that published several papers about sustainable primary care models. Dr Green is the editor-in-chief for the Journal of Chiropractic Education. He also is a part-time faculty member at the National University of Health Sciences where he serves as the associate editor for National's three journals: The Journal of Manipulative and Physiological Therapeutics, The Journal of Chiropractic Medicine and The Journal of Chiropractic Humanities.
